Driving onto the expansive grounds, you'll understand why internationally-recognized course designer, Ron Garl said of his work at Money Hill, "Nature did the hard work. I just added the finishing touches." The rolling contours of the terrain have 15 to 35 foot elevation changes with hills and valleys - from tee to green and hole to hole throughout the course. Their unusual 5-tee-box design offers challenging play for the most and least experienced players in your party.

The main clubhouse is flanked by the swim and tennis center. Its rustic elegance in the style of Frank Lloyd Wright houses a full-service Pro Shop, meeting rooms and casual dining in The Grille. The view from the club house showcases spectacular sunset views and the tree-lined, 150-acre lake over the 18th green. It's a place where friendships flourish and generations grow together with time.

To the right of the club facility a new solar cart pavillion is under construction and a fleet of whisper-quiet electric carts await the completion later this spring. A new 4.2 mile Nature and Hiking Trail was completed in April. The rustic trail, open to members and owners only, winds its way along the opposite side of the lake amid a lush growth of seasonal wild flowers, native animal life and towering pines.

The course is bounded by the residential community on one side and 3,500 acres of nature preserves. Wildlife research studies are carried on year round here and abundant wildlife, including nesting bald eagles, are a common, tranquil sight for golfers. The community was voted one of the 2010 Top Five in the State by online voters at Encore Louisiana (visit www.encorelouisiana.com for details), Best Environmental Community by the St. Tammany Home Builders Association in 2009 and its developer was awarded the 2009 Environmentalist of the Year by The Louisiana Nature Conservancy.

Don't let the tranquility fool you. Money Hill has been routinely named among the top courses in the State since it opened and has played host to the U.S. Open Qualifier, LGA State Fourball Championship, Gulf States PGA Championship, LGA Women's Golf Association State Amateur, LA State Amateur Championship and Senior U.S. Open Qualifier. For serious students of the game, The Rob Noel Golf Academy is a permanent part of the landscape and sits alongside a 30 acre, multi-faceted practice complex. Rob Noel was named the Top Golf Instructor in the South by the PGA in December 2009.

Situated on the 150-acre artesian spring fed lake, the course's final five holes may be the most memorable as they present every type of water hole. You'll play towards, around, along and across the lake.
